Apostrophes for possession (plural use)

Here are the rules for the use of apostrophes for possession and several examples:

<u>Plural use -</u> The apostrophe is placed after the plural form of the word; –s is not added if the plural already ends in –s, but is added if the plural does not end in –s (i.e. is an irregular plural – e.g. children's)	
Examples: Girls' Boys' Babies' Children's Men's Mice's
